

****Effective Monday, September 14, 2020****

Fabens ISD will provide free “grab n go” curbside meals to all children in the community (with federal/state approval).

Meals will be available 10:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. to all children ages 1-18 at the following campuses:

- Fabens Elementary (by bus stop area)
- O’Donnell Intermediate School
- Fabens Middle School
- Fabens High School

The student/child must be present during the pick-up. If student/child cannot accompany parent during pick up, the parent/guardian can pick up the meals by presenting the following documentation:

- Individual Report Card
- Student ID Card
- Official letter/email from school listing children enrolled at campus
- Birth Certificate for children not in school

Once this is verified, parents will be provided with a “Notice/Card” indicating they have been verified and will not be required to bring the documentation daily.

Child Nutrition Service employees will place the meals in the trunks or back seats of vehicle in order to maintain social distancing measures. Please note the following:

- Parents are asked to remain in the vehicle and open the trunk or back of vehicle
- If in a truck or SUV, where the back cannot be opened, CN Employees will provide the meal on a tray to lessen unnecessary contact or the meal can be placed in the back seat if unoccupied
- If possible, parents are encouraged to please place a box or bin in the trunk which will help hold the meals bags upright and keep the integrity of the meals.

If you have students that are attending school at the campuses, both breakfast and lunch will be provided at their designated campus. No duplicate meals will be served.
