What is it?	Fabens Elementary school is committed to our vision: Fabens Elementary is where minds, hands, and hearts come together to prepare our students for the future. We strive to provide high-quality education that is individualized to meet the needs of each student by developing and maintaining strong relationships with families and the community. One way that we continue to do this is by participating in the Title I, Part A State Program. The Title I program provides funding for low socio-economic schools. In return, the campus commits to meet the expectations laid out for participating schools by the Texas Education Agency and the United States Department of Education. The Texas Education Agency is the state agency that oversees primary and secondary public education. It is headed by the commissioner of education. The Texas Education Agency improves outcomes for all public-school students in the state by providing leadership, guidance, and support to school systems.
Funding	Title I funds will be allocated for the implementation of the parent and family engagement program. These procedures, programs, and activities will be planned with meaningful consultation with the parents of participating children.

Assessments are developed by the district instructional leadership and include both passed released State of Texas Assessment of Academic Readiness (STAAR) assessments as well as other curricular assessments.
